

## A Splash of Red

Different style earrings but all with a good splash of red to brighten up any outfit.



### Nina's Easy Drop Earrings

#### Ingredients

- 2 x FN016 silver headpins
- 4 x MB004 4mm silver metal beads (A)
- 2 x GL2371 red SL Diamonds (B)
- Pair of FN006 small silver fishhooks

#### To Make

This is the easiest style of earring to make, just choose a beautiful feature bead and in less than 5 minutes you have new earrings!  
Onto a headpin thread 1A, 1B, 1A. Trim and loop.  
Attach an earwire.  
Repeat to make the other earring.

If you have not made earrings before you will find the 'Loops and Linking' download on the Techniques page helpful so that you can learn about loops and, with a little practice, make perfect results every time

#### TIP

To keep your lengths uniform on both earrings it is best to trim all of the pins first and put half aside for the second earring.

### Louisa's Silver and Red Tassel Earrings

#### Ingredients

- 4 x FN016 silver headpins
- 2 x FN014 silver eyepins
- 4 x MB002 2mm silver metal beads (A)
- 4 x PP094 4mm silver bicone (B)
- 4 x FG419 4mm dark red facets (C)
- 2 x GL3283 16mm cushioned disc (D)
- Pair of FN006 small silver fishhook earwires

#### To Make

Cut one headpin down to 30mm long and one to 35mm long. Onto each thread 1B and 1C and loop the ends.  
Open the loop on an eyepin and attach the two loops just made. Close the loop.  
Thread on 1A, 1D, 1A. Trim and loop. Attach an earwire.  
Repeat to make the other earring.



### Nina's Double Hoop Earrings

#### Ingredients

- 8 x FN016 gold headpins
- 2 x MB668 14mm gold solid hoops (A)
- 2 x MB669 20mm gold solid hoops (B)
- 4 x MB003 3mm gold metal beads (C)
- 2 x GL2378 red SL cushion (D)
- 12 x RC278 size 10 gold seed beads (E)
- 6 x RC273 size 8 gold seed beads (F)
- 16 x RC154 size 8 SL red seed beads (G)
- Pair of FN001 gold fishhook earwires

#### To Make

Onto a headpin thread 1E, 1G, 1F, 1G, 1E. Trim and loop. Make another pin the same.  
Onto a headpin thread 1E, 2G, 1F, 2G, 1E. Trim and loop.  
Attach the three pins just made to the large hoop B with the longer pin in the centre.  
Onto a headpin thread 1C, 1D, 1C. Trim and loop - make the loop quite generous in size. Attach the loop just made to the top of the hoop with the dangles on, and the bottom of the small hoop (A).  
Attach an earwire to the top of the small hoop to complete.  
Repeat to make the other earring.
