

Spellbound Team Charm Bracelet

Ingredients

- 4 x GL3192 10mm crystal flower (A)
- 3 x GL3193 14mm crystal flower (B)
- 2 x GL3191 14mm crystal heart (C)
- 5 x MB651 10mm silver twist flower (D)
- 2 x MB652 15mm silver twist flower (E)
- 4 x MB673 flower link (F)
- 5 x MB672 heart link (G)
- 2 x GL3053 10mm crystal round (H)
- 3 x MB640 16mm flower filigree (J)
- 40 x FN142 6mm jump ring (K)
- FN024 medium lobster (L)
- 1m of 0.6mm half hard silver plated wire
- 10cm of 0.8mm half hard silver plated wire



If you have not made wrapped loops before take a look at the [Wrapped Loops & Balls](#) download on the Techniques tab and take a few practice runs to get the technique right - it is a technique that really needs practice to perfect but it is worth it!

To Make

This was a team make - charm bracelets are a great way to get lots of practise in on your wrapped loops so we all made a few to get warmed up and then linked them up into a charm bracelet.

Make up all the A, B and C beads into charms using the 0.6mm wire

Cut a short length of 0.6mm wire and turn a loop on the end, thread on 1H, trim and loop. Make another link the same, call these links 'Z'

Make up the central chain of the bracelet as follows :-

1L, 1D, 2L, 1J, 2L, 1D, 1L, 1E, 1L, 1Z, 1L, 1J, 1L, 1Z, 1L, 1E, 1L, 1J, 1L, 1D, 1L

Using the remaining jump rings to attach the charms and links that you have left along the length of the bracelet - take the time to lay them out and make a plan before you start though so that you get an effect that pleases you.

Variations on a Theme

This bracelet has been made using a variety of links with crystal shapes for the wrapped loop drops

Change it around for your bracelet by mixing your metals - gold, silver and copper and using metallic beads for the drops too for an industrial look.

Take an element of the bracelet to make the focal point of a necklace, then attach it to multiple lengths of chain, interspersing the chain with links from the design for a really bold necklace.

Instead of making a necklace that has a curve at the front, take a small section of the bracelet - about 3 inches/7.5cm long - and put a link on one end through which to run a length of chain or thong to make a simple, elegant pendant piece.

Use any one, or more, of the links in the bracelet to make matching earrings.
