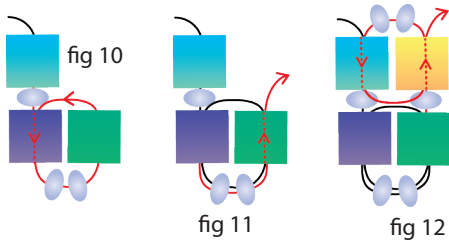
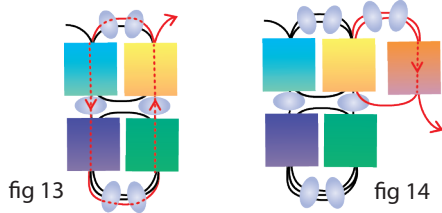


Square Stitch

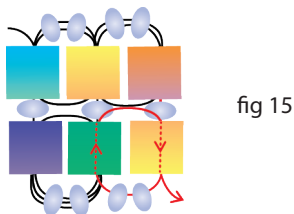
Thread on 1C, 1S, 1C, 2S and 1C. Pass the needle through the second C bead in the same direction as before to bring the last 2C beads alongside one another (fig 10). Pass the needle through the following 2S and 1C (fig 11).



Thread on 1S, 1C and 2S. Pass the needle through the first C bead in the same direction as before and the last C bead added (fig 12). Pass the needle through the following 2S, down the beads of the first row and up the beads of the second row to emerge from the last C bead (fig 13) - this makes the work more firm.

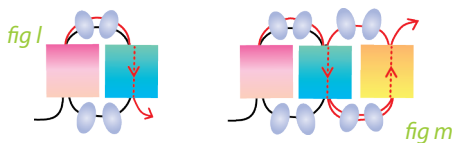


Thread on 2S and 1C. Stitch this C bead to the last C bead of the previous row as before (fig 14). Thread on 1S, 1C and 2S. Stitch this new C to the first C bead of the previous row (fig 15). Pass the needle up and down the beads of the previous row and the new row (as fig 13) before starting the next row with 2S and 1C.



Tutti Frutti Rings

- 1 Prepare the needle with 1m of double thread and tie a keeper bead 10cm from the ends.
- 2 Referring to the Ladder Stitch instruction box thread on 1C, 2S, 1C and 2S. Pass the needle through the first C again to bring the 2C beads parallel.
- 3 Pass the needle through the following 2S and 1C (fig l). Thread on 2S, 1C and 2S. Pass the needle through the previous C bead, the first 2S just added and the last C added (fig m).

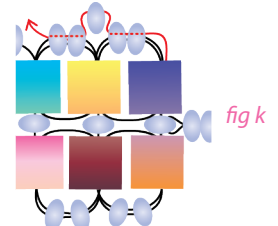


- 4 Repeat fig l until the strip is long enough to go around the finger. Join the first C to the last C using 2S beads on either edge. Pass the needle through the S beads along first one edge and then the other to make the ring firm. Finish off the thread neatly and securely.



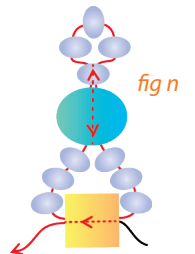
Tutti-Frutti Bracelet

- 1 Prepare the needle with 1.5m of single thread and tie a keeper bead 10cm from the end.
- 2 Follow the instructions in the Square Stitch instruction box to work a strip of beading long enough for your wrist.
- 3 Pass the needle through the last row to emerge from the central S bead. Thread on 4S, a clasp bead and 4S. Complete the clasp bead tag as in fig 1 in the Straight-Stringing instruction box.
- 4 Pass the needle through the middle S bead on the end of the bracelet and the following 1C and 2S along the edge. Thread on 1S and pass through the next 2S beads along the edge (fig k). Repeat right down the edge - you may not need to add 1S in each gap - see how it goes.
- 5 When you get to the far end of this edge pass through the first C and the middle S beads on the end row.
- 6 Make the loop end of the clasp as in fig 2 in the Straight-Stringing instruction box. Pass the needle down the other edge of the bracelet to add the extra S beads before finishing off the thread ends securely.



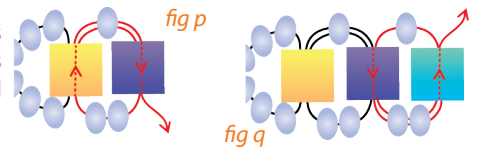
Tutti Frutti Necklace

- 1 Prepare the needle with 1.8m of double thread and tie a keeper bead 10cm from the ends.
- 2 Thread on 1C, 3S, a clasp bead and 4S. Pass the needle back through the first S bead of the 4S and the clasp bead. Thread on 3S. Pass through the C bead in the same direction as before (fig n) to form a triangular shaped support for the clasp bead.



- 3 Read through the Ladder Stitch instruction box. The necklace is made in ladder stitch but to give it a curve you will need to add 2S beads between the C beads on one edge and just 1S bead on the other edge - make sure you keep to this pattern.
- 4 Thread on 1S, 1C and 2S. Pass the needle through the first C bead from step 2 and the following 1S and 1C just added (fig p).

- 5 Thread on 2S, 1C and 1S. Pass the needle through the previous C bead and the following 2S and 1C (fig q).
- 6 Repeat the stitches shown in figs p & q until the necklace is long enough. Make sure you keep the 2S to the one edge and 1S to the other edge of the weave.
- 7 Using a triangle of S beads to support it add a bead loop to the far end of the design as in fig 2 in the Straight Stringing instructions. Finish off the thread ends securely.
